Program Mission:

The mission of the Child Development Program at Jefferson State Community College is to provide a quality, innovative program of study and to promote Child Development (Early Care and Education) as a professional field of study. The program has three tracks: Educarer, Administrator, and Afterschool.

Program Outcomes:

- Employers and graduates will report at least a 75% satisfaction with educational preparation
- Graduation rate will be greater than viability requirement
- At least 80% of the graduates seeking employment will be employed one year after graduation in a position for which the program prepared them.

Program Level Student Learning Outcomes:

The SLOs are broad in scope and apply to Child Development as a whole which includes all three of the degree tracks within the program: Educarer, Administrator, and Afterschool)

1. Demonstrate competency in performing basic teaching and caring skills.
2. Demonstrate and utilize foundational knowledge of Child Development in providing care and learning opportunities for young children.
3. Develop competencies necessary to meet the needs of children and their families.
4. Utilize observation, assessment and evaluation in developing safe, healthy, learning opportunities for young children
5. Utilize a teaching/learning/communicating plan for culturally diverse children and families variety of settings.
6. Apply critical thinking skills in curriculum development in a variety of classroom settings.
7. Demonstrate professional behaviors associated with teachers of young children.
