

ADA Accommodations Office – Service Unit Outcomes

Service Unit Purpose:

The primary purpose of the Accommodations Office is to ensure equal access to classroom material by providing self-identified students who have disabilities with appropriate and reasonable accommodations and to disseminate information concerning accommodations to faculty, staff, and interested community members.

Service Unit Outcomes:

1. Students with disabilities will be aware of the services available by the ADA Office.
2. Information about academic accommodations will be provided to faculty, staff, students, prospective students, parents and appropriate professionals and outside agencies.
3. Students who have the required documentation will receive reasonable and appropriate accommodations.
4. Accessibility to classroom material will be supported by providing information, assistive equipment, scribes, readers, note takers sign language interpreters, captionists and test proctoring.
5. Confidential records will be maintained for all self-identified students with disabilities.
