Service Unit Purpose:

The Chilton-Clanton Center of Jefferson State Community College is an instructional site created to specifically serve the educational needs of our students in Chilton County and the surrounding areas. It is a place where students will be able to register for classes, pay tuition, see an advisor, and successfully meet their educational goals.
