We have used the results to help us focus on the weaknesses of our students and correct gaps in instruction.

			Using FISDAP has allowed to assure that each student meets the required minimum competencies at all levels of certification at the rate of 100% and allows the students and instructors to follow their progress. Clinical performance data was entered into FISDAP to track student's individual performance; all students were required to meet the posted minimum requirements.
